1100 School District Legal Status

1140 Director District Boundaries

It is the responsibility of the Board of Directors to establish the boundaries of the internal director districts of the school district and to redistrict the director districts as necessary.

The Board of Directors, with the assistance of the administration and the Educational Service District, and the State Redistricting Commission, shall develop a plan of proposed director districts within eight months of any of the following events:

1. Receipt of federal decennial census data;
2. Consolidation of the district with one or more other districts;
3. Transfer of territory to or from the district;
4. Annexation of territory to or from the district; or
5. Approval by a majority of the district's voters of a proposal to divide the district into director districts.

The plan of proposed director districts shall meet the following criteria:

1. The districts shall be as nearly as possible equal in population;
2. The districts shall be as compact as possible and consist of geographically contiguous area;
3. The districts shall not favor or disfavor any racial group or political party; and
4. The districts shall as much as possible coincide with natural boundaries and existing communities.

At least one week before the Board of Directors considers adoption of the plan of director districts, the Board shall hold a public hearing on the plan.

Within thirty (30) days of adoption of the plan of director districts, the legal descriptions and maps depicting the director districts shall be submitted to the county auditor. If the plan is submitted after the fourth Monday in June of an odd-numbered year, the plan will not take effect until the following year.

Any registered voter in the district may challenge the plan within 45 days of the plan's adoption by requesting that the superior court review the plan for compliance with the four criteria listed above.

DIRECTOR DISTRICT BOUNDARIES

The board of directors shall establish director district boundaries according to policy #1140. Following the established policy, the board has modified the director district boundaries and approved the boundaries of each of the five director districts as described below:

**Director District #1**

Starting at the intersection of school district and northern crossing of I-5. South on I-5 to 172nd Street East on 172nd Street to Smokey Point Blvd. South on Smokey Point Blvd to 168th Street East on 168th Street to 41st Drive. South on 41st Drive to 165th Place West on 165th Place to Smokey Point Blvd. South Smokey Point Blvd to city limits (16025 Smokey Point Blvd). East on City Limits to the school district boundary. North following the school district boundary to the point of beginning.

**Director District 2**

Starting at the intersection of school district and the southern crossing of 11th Avenue. North on 11th Avenue to 148th Street. East on 148th Street to Forty Five Road. Northwest on Forty Five Road to McRae Road. West on McRae Road to Freestad Road. West on Freestad to Lake Ki. Northwest through Lake Ki to 27th Drive. North on 27th Drive to Lakewood Road. Easterly on Lakewood Road to 172nd Street. East on 172nd Street to Smokey Point Blvd. South on Smokey Point Blvd to 168th Street. East on 168th Street to 41st Drive. South on 41st Drive to 165th Place. West on 165th Place to Smokey Point Blvd. South Smokey Point Blvd. to city limits (16025 Smokey Point Blvd). East on City Limits to the school district boundary. South following the school district boundary to the point of beginning.

**Director District 3**

Starting at the intersection of school district and the southern crossing of 11th Avenue. North on 11th Avenue to 148th Street. East on 148th Street to Forty Five Road. Northwest on Forty Five Road to McRae Road. West on McRae Road to 16th Avenue. South of 16th Avenue to 158th Street. West on 158th Street to 156th Street. West on 156th Street and extension to Lake Goodwin. Southwest through Lake Goodwin to 152nd Place. West on 152nd Place to West Lake Goodwin Road. North on West Lake Goodwin Road to 156th Street. West on 156th Street to 56th Avenue. South on 56th Avenue to the school district boundary. East following the school district boundary to the point of beginning.

**Director District 4**

Starting at the intersection of school district and 188th Street (2800 188th St). West following 188th Street to 40th Avenue. South on 40th Avenue to Lakewood Road. East on Lakewood Road to 27th Drive. South on 27th Drive to Lake Ki. Southeast through Lake Ki to Freestad Drive. Southeast on Freestad Drive to McRae Road. Southerly on McRae Road to 16th Avenue. South of 16th Avenue to 158th Street. West on 158th Street to 156th Street. West on 156th Street and extension to Lake Goodwin. Southwest through Lake Godwin to 152nd Place. West on 152nd Place to West Lake Goodwin Road. North on West Lake Goodwin Road to 156th Street. West on 156th Street to 56th Avenue. South on 56th Avenue to the school district boundary. North following the school district boundary to the point of beginning.

**Director District 5**

Starting at the intersection of school district and 188th Street (2800 188th Street). West following 188th Street to 40th Avenue. South on 40th Avenue to Lakewood Road. East on Lakewood Road to 172nd Street. East on 172nd Street to I-5. North on I-5 to the school district boundary. North following the school district boundary to the point of beginning.
