1200 School Board Legal Status

1210 Authority

The Board of Directors is the local governing body of the school district and functions under powers delegated to it by the state legislature. Its legal powers, duties and responsibilities are derived from state statute. Sources such as the Session Laws, Attorney General's opinions, and regulations of the State Board of Education delineate the legal powers, duties and responsibilities of the Board of Directors.

The Board considers itself a legislative unit with no one member having authority except when delegated by the Board. No board member may speak for the Board of Education unless appointed to do so. No formal actions may be taken except at a regular or special meeting of the board legally convened with a quorum present.
