1330 Board-Staff Relations

The function of the Board is primarily legislative. The Board recognizes that the administration of Board policy is a task for the professional. Therefore the Board selects a competent Superintendent of Schools, who is an expert in the field of education, and acts upon the general policies when approved, and in the actual management of the educational system the executive is given complete control as long as he/she is in charge and as long as he/she carries out the general policies when they have been approved by the Board.

The Board should define administrative responsibility and authority of its Chief Executive Officer. The Chief Executive Officer will set up a line-staff organization including duties and responsibilities of administrative officers.

The Board should set up principles of inter-relationship and working procedure whereby the Board, the Superintendent, district employees and community members can exercise wide participation in determining the operation of the schools. Any such procedures must be consistent with legal board policy and all requirements and existing statutes.
