



## **FAMILY AND STUDENT ACCESS OVERVIEW**

The Lakewood School District will be implementing Family Access during the 2008-09 school year for grades 6-12. Family Access is a Web module that allows family members to access student information over the Internet via a secured web connection in real-time. Initially Family Access will be configured so that parents/guardians and students have access to student information such as attendance, calendar, family demographics, fee management, test scores, schedules, and current grades. Usernames and passwords issued to students will be different from the usernames and passwords issued to their parent/guardians.

Family Access allows parents/guardians to become more involved in their student's education. Families can take an active role in assisting students and improving their educational experience. The technology raises awareness in the community of the school district's educational efforts by opening additional lines of communication between the guardians and the school.

If you are a student or parent of a student attending Lakewood Middle School or Lakewood High School and you have not received your usernames and passwords contact your child's school or stop by the district office to obtain this information.
