

DISTRICT PROGRAMS FOR LAKEWOOD STUDENTS

Highly Capable Program (K -12)

The gifted educational program is for students who have been identified with unusually high potential and require different programs that take into consideration individual learning styles and special abilities.

Title I (K-2)

Gives reading/math tutorial assistance for identified students.

Learning Assistance Program (3-6)

Gives reading/math tutorial assistance for identified students.

Special Education (Pre-School-12)

The Special Education Program identifies students whose disability adversely impacts educational performance and who require specially designed instruction to improve their educational performance.

Bilingual Education Program (K -12)

Program designed to provide a transitional bilingual program for children whose primary language is not English, and whose English skills are sufficiently deficient or absent as to impair learning.

Career and Technical Education Program (9-12)

Is a planned program of courses and learning experiences that begins with exploration of career options, supports basic academic and life skills and enables achievement of high academic standards, leadership preparation for industry defined work, advanced and continuing education.

Traffic Safety Program (9-12)

A before/after school program designed for youthful drivers for the purpose of mastering safe skills, behaviors and procuring a driver's license.

Summer School Program (9-12)

The Summer Education program supports struggling students to meet grade level contract standards.

Early Childhood Education Assistance Program (Pre-School)

A young child and family will substantially benefit from a comprehensive pre-kindergarten program that fosters "whole child" development, identifies and remedies health and developmental problems to increase skills in preparation for success in schools and society.
